What is the Young Ambassadors Programme?

The **FAIR GAME** Young Ambassadors Programme will empower 30 young people, aged 14–18, to become advocates for safer, fairer and more inclusive online gaming. Participants will join a European network of Young Ambassadors, working together to raise awareness of digital rights, online safety and children's rights while promoting positive gaming communities.



What will Young Ambassadors do?

- Receive training on digital rights and online safety.
- Join the Young Ambassadors Advisory Board.
- Design and implement awareness campaigns.
- Create digital content.
- Engage with peers, industry representatives and policymakers.

Who can participate?

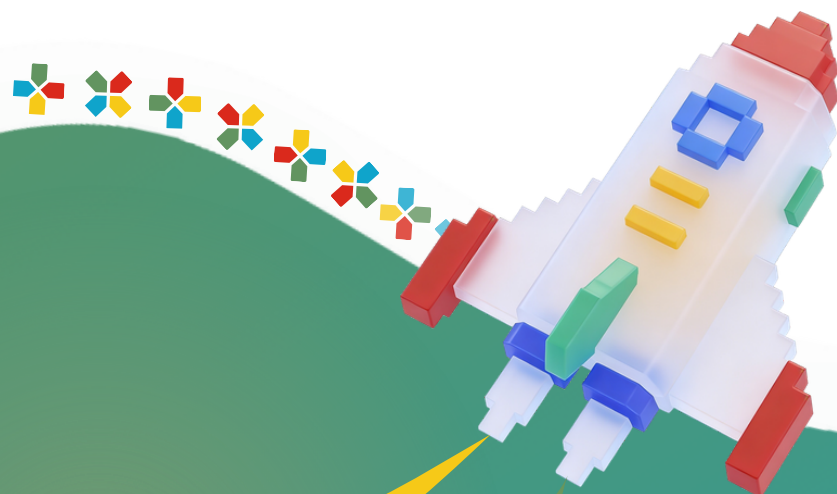
Young people aged **14–18** who:
